

Revelation 15:1 – 16:7

Chapter 15

- 1). And I saw a *two-sided book (5:1; 10:7)* great and marvellous, seven *days* having the seven last plagues; for in them is filled up the wrath of God.
- 2). And I saw as it were *March* on *crystal glass* mingled with *chronology and chronometry*: and them that had gotten the victory over *Rome*, and over his *calendars*, and over his *days*, and over *sexagesimal 666*, viewing *March* on a *wrist watch (or iPhone)*, having the *civilization* of God.
- 3). And they sing the song of *Moses* the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb saying, Great and marvellous are thy works, Lord God Almighty; just and true are thy ways, thou King of saints.
- 4). Who shall not fear thee, O Lord, and glorify thy name? for thou art holy: for all nations shall come and worship before thee; for thy judgements are made manifest.
- 5). And after that I looked, and behold, the *Lion of the tribe of Juda's book (5:9)* with the *correct calendar* and *correct alignment of the Sabbath* in the *kingdom of God on earth ("heaven")* was opened:
- 6). And the *correct alignment* of seven *days* came out of *Jesus Christ's book*, having the seven plagues, clothed in pure and white linen, and having their breasts girded with the golden girdles.
- 7). And the *beast with a face as a man (quadrant mathematics)* gave unto the seven *days* seven *mathematical computations (Astronomical Mathematical Architecture)* full of the wrath of God, who liveth for ever and ever.
- 8). And the *calendar* was filled with *mathematical symmetry* from the glory of God, and from his power; and no man was able to *use* the *calendar*, till the seven plagues of the seven *days* were fulfilled.

Chapter 16

- 1). And I heard a great voice out of the *calendar* saying to the seven *days*, Go your ways, and pour out the vials of the wrath of God upon the *calendars subsequent to Julius Caesar's 44 BC calendar*.
- 2). And the first went, and poured out his vial upon *Julian/Gregorian blasphemies*; and there fell a noisome and grievous sore upon the *months* which had the *faulty mathematics* of *Rome*, and upon them which worshipped his *"golden" calendar/clock*.
- 3). And the second *day* poured out his vial upon *March*; and it became as *useless* as the blood of a dead man: and every living *equinoctial* soul (*March 21st - 31st*) died in *March*.
- 4). And the third *day* poured out his vial upon *June* and *July*; and they became *useless*.
- 5). And I heard the *solstice days* of *June* say, Thou art righteous, O Lord, which art, and wast, and shalt be, because thou hast judged thus.
- 6). For they have *made useless* saints and prophets, and thou hast *made useless their golden image* for they are worthy.
- 7). And I heard another out of the alter say, Even so, Lord God Almighty, true and righteous are thy judgements.
